You have 24 hours to cancel your reservation. A valid credit card is required with every reservation made. After 24 hours your reservation is subject to our cancellation policy below.


All cancellations of lodging units or marina rentals 90 days or more from the arrival or rental date will be charged a \$100 processing fee plus forfeiture of any booking fee paid. Any cancellation made less than 90 days of arrival results in forfeiture of 100% of deposit and booking fee. Any cancellation made within 14 days of arrival will be charged the full amount of the reservation. No exceptions will be given. If you have concerns about our cancellation policy you should purchase travel insurance online.
